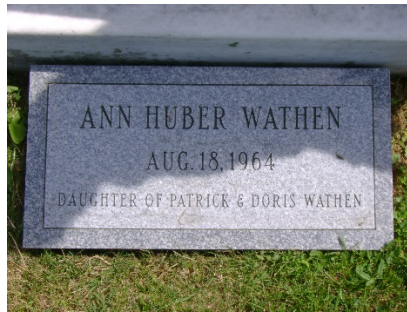


Saint John the Baptist Catholic Cemetery Cremation Policy

- The Roman Catholic Church allows cremation.
- The Roman Catholic Church does have policies on cremation ashes disposal.
 - Cremated ashes should be respectfully buried.
 - Two Cremated bodies should not be mixed and buried.
 - Cremation ashes should not be scattered.
- Our cemetery allows ashes to be buried at no charge on plots presently owned by a family member or an approving relative.
 - Monuments for this individual must be placed at ground level and in front of present monuments.



- Separate above ground monuments at side of a present monument are not allowed.
 - Burial of ashes must be cleared with cemetery and recorded on cemetery plot maps along with physical date of burial.
 - Ashes must be buried at least six inches in from gravesite boundaries.
- Ashes buried in a separate burial plot.
 - Present gravesite purchase policy costs, rules and fees will be followed.
 - Gravesites under this use, must have a monument marker stating name, date of birth and date of death. This can be a small in ground marker, veteran marker or standard size monument allowed by cemetery policy.
- This cemetery does not allow scattering of cremation ashes.
